While you are a student in the Luthier Program, you may utilize the Fab Lab during regular business hours and open lab time to work on your instruments. The Fab Lab is open most days for individual use Monday through Friday from 9am to 4pm. You can schedule to work in the lab anytime during the week. Open Lab is also offered off-hours and can include nights & weekends. These lab hours are scheduled weekly and fees vary. It is suggested to call to book an appointment to work in the lab.

Specialty work and/or consultation services are available. We also offer one-on-one instruction with our skilled instructors. Pricing varies.

The Luthier Certification Program can accommodate students ages 16 years and older.
